Your Courage Can Save Someone's Life

The survival rate is nearly zero within 10 minutes of cardiac arrest if no action is taken

AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is a life-saving medical device that anyone can use. Using an AED increases survival rate by 7.6 times and the social reintegration rate by 12.9 times after one month, compared to no life-saving treatment.

Treatment Before Emergency Medical Services Arrived	One-month Survival Rate	One-month Social Recovery Rate
No Treatment	6.6%	3.3%
Life-saving Treatment (Without AED)	9.9%	6.2%
Life-saving Treatment (With AED)	50.3%	42.6%

Takeuchi Shrine Annual Festival (September 14th-16th)

Takeuchi Shrine Festival originally started in the Kyoho period of the Edo era. The shrine's portable shrine and children's portable shrines and floats from 5 communities will parade along the approach to the shrine. This is the largest festival in Abiko City, which conveys the history of prosperity in Fusa area. This festival is designated as a city's cultural property (intangible folk property).

On the first day, the shrine's portable shrine will climb down the steep stone steps of the Takeuchi shrine and parade with other portable shrines and floats from the communities.

On the final day, all the portable shrines and floats will gather in the parking lot of GRAND KITCHEN NARITAYA FUSA store for a joint performance.

Child Allowance System Revised in October

Main Changes in Child Allowance

- 1. Extension of the payment period: The payment period is extended to the first March 31st after the child reaches the age of 18.
- 2. Abolition of income limits: Income limits are removed.
- 3. Increase in allowance for the third child and beyond: The allowance for the third child and subsequent children is increased to ¥30,000 per month.
- 4. The allowance will be paid 6 times per year.
- 5. The period of eligibility to be counted as a child is extended until the first March 31 after the child reaches the age of 22 (in case the child is taken care of by a guardian).

^{*}Information on the procedure was sent to eligible households at the end of August.
